 and unto her sume of Thrice hundred pounds a pinte scut of Denre Wounds a pinte wine
 grained then by the first flower my late father Robert said Denre Wounds a pinte wine which
 shall be compayneded in the said three hundred pounds lidd of wine and bequeath unto
 my other daugher hisse and Sarah to sume of Three hundred Wounds a pinte to be paid
 to every and either of my said daughters at theire severall dayes of marriage and if they
 happen so to be married before they accomplish the age of one and Twenty yeare then my
 will and meaning is that from thenceforth the interest of thire said severall portions and
 sume of money shall be paid them both to thire age or age of Twenty yeard or dayes of marriage
 in respect of either of the said sumes my will is to give said interest portion and sume of money (half)
 to be paid them by her person or her selfe to be used hereafter to be named provided that if either of
 them dy before such dayes or times before mentioned that then her or thire part or portion
 heretofore given shall not be payable to any other but be ad if no such Legacy or Bequest had
 been made or given. It is my will also and bequeath unto John Waller my brother in Law the sume
 of fiftie Wounds to be paid within one year after my death Item to give unto Dame Waller wife of
 my said brother Waller the like sume of fiftie Wounds to be paid within one year after my death
 Item of wine unto Mr. John Howler his son Twenty Pintes and unto Sarah Howler daughter
 of my said sonne the like sume of Twenty Pintes Item of wine unto Dame Elizabeth
 after her decease thirty Pintes where said legacy to be paid at one yere end after my
 death Item my will is that my trusty and loving frind Dame Elizabeth the younger of the City of
 Worcester Thomas Webb of Wetheridge in the Parish of Rodeborough Doctor Thomas Waller late
 in the Marish of Stonehouse Shelsby and Chistian minister of Worcester in the said Marish of
 Stonehouse C. and or the survivor or survivors of them or the major part of them shall and may
 and hereby I give them power and authority to demis sell and let all or any my inclosed Hys
 Lands Cemments and hereditaments wchffence and the rents and profits thereof to receive entir
 my son Daniel Howler shall accomplish the age of one and Twenty yeard and that my son
 theire trusty and profite to servise ad all out of the interest and interest of all sume of money
 shall allong and pay for sufficent maintenance for the breeding and educating my said children
 until such time as my said son shall arrive to the age of one and Twenty yeard and all out
 age my will is my said son shall be at the charge of his education and breeding and
 give said severall dayes of marriage or age of one and Twenty yeard lidd of twenty
 deince my sonne Johnman the said Mr. Thomas Webb or Thomas Waller to be called up and
 instruct my said son in the trade of Glazier in the town and family of him the said Mr.
 Webb or Mr. Thomas Waller to be called up said sume age of twenty yeare when he
 recyving and retayning sufficent and reasonable allowance for his same. Item if my
 perhauill estate shall not suffice to pay and disburse the said legaried sume of money
 and perhauill hereby deuided or to be deuided it shall then bee lawfull to the said Daniel
 Elizabeth Thomas Webb Thomas Glazier and Chistian Howler the survivor or
 survivors of them or the major part of them to retaine somme of the rents issued and
 profits rofery they shall have received to add to and make up the said severall
 portions and sume of money hereby given and if it shall happen the said not have

be or else at the discretion of my Executor dead for my worldy Estate & dispose of
had fowlely affirte & give and bequeath to my chaste son Doctor William fullwood
all my freehold and lease hold Messaged Lands and Tenements whatsoever libat-
ting and leving within the pertinents and bounds of Huntington aforesaid to him and
to his to him and his heire executors and assignes respectively Item of give unto
the said William fullwood and his heire forever one parcell of Land lying in the
field of Goodman's field in the County of Huntington aforesaid now in the occupancy
of Edward Drift of Goodman's field aforesaid Item of give unto the said William
fullwood all my interest and tenement of yeard yet to come and purcipated in my lease
made to the by the right honorable Elizabeth late Countess Dowager of Exeter
